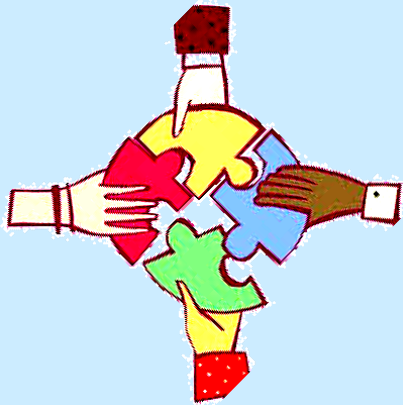

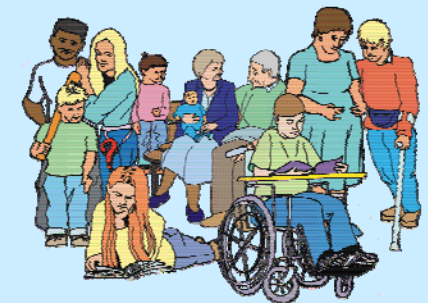

Community Living

Community Inclusion - Social and recreation opportunities for adults with disabilities. We provide support to join in community based activities in addition to our art programs, social groups and life skill programs.

Employment - Organizational employment or community based employment opportunities are provided for individuals who are looking to expand their daily activities.

Residential Supports - Home Sharing, Respite Care, or Support to live independently are some of the options available from PDSCL and funded by Community Living BC.

After School Youth Group for teens with disabilities provides a safe and activity filled program for disabled teens.



Funding for our programs is provided by Community Living BC, Ministry of Children and Family Development and through our services, such as our Wood Shop, Bike Shop and Market Place.

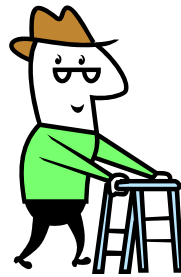
Social Housing

PDSCL and BC Housing have partnered on a number of projects to meet the housing needs our community.

We manage more than 200 subsidized rental units in Penticton. We support families, single adults, seniors and those with physical or intellectual disabilities with safe and affordable housing.



Supports for Seniors



Operating the Penticton Retirement Centre in partnership with BC Housing and Interior Health Authority we are able to offer Assisted Living and Seniors Supportive Housing programs for those in need.

Subsidized rental apartments without care support are also available. The Leisure Centre provides space for many community activities .

Our Organization

PDSCL is a not-for-profit charitable organization that provides housing and support services to individuals with developmental and physical disabilities, seniors and families with limited incomes.

The organization was created in 1958 by a group of committed parents who wanted to ensure their children with disabilities received an education. Since its initial inception, the Society has evolved to meet the ever-changing needs of our consumers and the community.

Our organizational structure consists of a Board of Directors, an Executive, and an Executive Director. Board members are involved at many levels in the operation of the Society, including finance, fund-raising, volunteer activities, housing and most importantly, the setting of goals and objectives for the Society.

PDSCL programs and services are provided by various numbers of support staff in each area and a manager who works closely with the Executive Director who reports directly to the Board of Directors.
